

# Bradley University Student Senate

## A Resolution to Raise Awareness

*Be it enacted by the Student Senate here assembled that:*

1. Whereas, Bradley University is committed educating it's students, in all matters pertaining to awareness; and,
2. Whereas, raising awareness of any issue, to promote education and advocacy, eliminates ignorance; and,
3. Whereas, 25% of Bradley students surveyed were aware that October is National Bullying Prevention Month; and,
4. Whereas, students are always in and out of the lobby of residence halls; and,
5. Whereas, bulleting boards, size 24" x 18", provide an area to create messages, can easily be changed of messages posted, and are large enough to catch the attention of people; and,
6. Whereas, they will cost approximately \$15 each
7. Therefore, be it resolved that the Bradley University Student Senate recommends the following actions be taken:
  - a. A bulletin board shall be placed in the lobby of each of the public residence halls: Harper / Wyckoff, Heitz, Geisert, University, College, and Williams.
  - b. The previous month awareness message must be taken down after the end of the month, but the new awareness message must be posted on the bulletin boards by the 5<sup>th</sup> of every month.

- c. A Student Senators Representatives, from each hall, shall have the duty of raising awareness, and creating the bulletin boards.
- d. Student Senators use rhetorical choices in choosing which awareness issue shall be displayed in the bulleting board for that particular month.
- e. The Student Senators must make the board creative and appealing to raise the attraction level of residence, but may use their own discretion as to what “appealing” and “creative” entails.
